The Australian Services Union is made up of tens of thousands of workers who have banded together to protect and improve our wages and conditions, and to have a voice about the things that impact on our lives.

The Local Government sector is one of the largest industries that the ASU covers. We've been there alongside Local Government workers for over 100 years. ASU members' success is evident in the good working conditions and wages that can be found in Local Government.

The ASU assists members to improve their wages and conditions through collective bargaining, to address ongoing issues through their workplace consultative and Work Health and Safety committees, and to successfully resolve individual issues that arise from time to time.

Our big focus in Local Government is Job Security - for example, limiting the number of employees on fixed term contracts, converting those already on contracts into permanent positions, campaigning against the outsourcing of services, and blocking attempts to abolish no forced redundancies in the sector.

We also campaign on things that matter to our Local Government members. For example, in 2018 and again in 2020 we campaigned to block the introduction of rate capping in South Australia. We successfully protected local services from being cut by highlighting the valuable work Council workers do in our local communities.
